



MATE ACT CONFERENCES

The MATE Act requires DEA licensees demonstrate that they have completed EIGHT HOURS of relevant accredited education.

- DEA-registered physicians and practitioners must complete training on treating and managing patients with opioid or other substance use disorders before applying for a license or having their license renewed.
- Applies to new or renewing DEA registrants.
- Training does not have to occur in one session, and past trainings do count!
- MATE Act is a one-time requirement.
